

SUBSCRIPTION

How to subscribe

Go in person to one of the nine Laval libraries or to the multi-service counter with the documents cited below.

- If you are a Laval resident, you will receive an Avantages Laval card free of charge. This card entitles you to receive library services.
- Non-residents can also get the card, though a fee does apply.

Subscriptions are valid for one year, after which you must renew your card by going in person to the library with a proof of residence.

Temporary subscription

You can also get a temporary one-month subscription by completing the application available on our online platform at [REPONSEATOUT.CA](https://reponseatout.ca). This subscription lets you reserve physical documents (books, DVDs, music, games), access all our digital resources, and borrow digital books.

In order to convert your temporary subscription to a regular subscription so that you can borrow physical documents, you must go in person to your library with a valid proof of residence.

Subscription categories

Subscriptions for children are available at the library. This subscription lets you borrow documents only from the youth collection. In addition, “Books for Baby” encourages parents to subscribe their children during the first 12 months of their lives.

Proof of residence from a parent or a guardian is required to subscribe or renew a subscription for children ages 11 and under.

Adult resident

Laval residents ages 12 and older

Type of card: Avantages Laval

Fee: Free of charge

Required documents: Identification document and proof of residence

Youth resident

Laval residents ages 11 and under

Type of card: Avantages Laval

Fee: Free of charge

Required documents: Identification document and proof of residence from a parent or legal guardian for children ages 11 and under

Adult taxpayer and non-resident

Adults with a Laval municipal tax account

Type of card: Avantages Laval

Fee: Free of charge

Required documents: Identification document and proof of residence, and a paid municipal tax statement.

Non-resident student

Students registered in an establishment located within Laval city limits.

Type of card: Library card

Fee: Free of charge

Required documents: Identification document and proof of residence, and proof of attendance at a school establishment within Laval city limits.

Adult non-resident

Non-residents of Laval ages 12 and older

Type of card: Avantages Laval

Fee: \$54

Required documents: Identification document and proof of residence

Youth non-resident

Non-residents of Laval ages 11 and under

Type of card: Avantages Laval

Fee: \$54

Required documents: Identification document and proof of residence from a parent or a legal guardian for children ages 11 and under

Community

Community daycare, CPE, school or organization

Type of card: Library card

Fee: Free of charge

Required documents: Please contact one of the libraries in Laval

Conditions

Can I lend my Avantages Laval card to someone?

Your Avantages Laval card is strictly for personal use, non-transferable, and under your sole responsibility. Lending it to someone is therefore prohibited. However, in the event that you have difficulty getting to the library in person, you can authorize someone to carry out your transactions at the counter by signing a power of attorney form beforehand. The form is available at the library.

What should I do if I lose my Avantages Laval card?

If you lose your card, please go to your library counter to get a new one. A replacement fee of \$5 will be applied.

How do I change my library record?

Subscribers must notify the library concerning any changes to their subscription.

- A change of address must be made at a library and requires proof of residence showing your new address.
- You can change your telephone number, email address and password directly in your library record.
